### 1) The EU climate policy





-20% CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 2020

-40% CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 2030



The President of the European Commission, **Ursula von der Leyen**, launched the new **European Green Deal** to accelerate the process towards the EU climate neutrality by 2050, with a potential updating of the EU 2030 target to 50-55%.

The European Green Deal is a broad roadmap that also deals with biodiversity and forests, agriculture and food, green cities and circular economy.

#### WHY SO IMPORTANT:

Cities are those places where more than 50% of the world's population lives today, 80% of GDP is produced and, last but not least, three quarters of climate-change gas emissions due to final energy consumption are emitted. That's why "the battle to save our planet is won or lost in cities".









and adoption of a joint approach to tackling **mitigation** and **adaptation** to climate change

**64,6%** of signatories submitted a **SEAP/SECAP** (27% expected average  $CO_2$  emission reduction by 2020) and **36,1%** of them (23,3% of total signatories) submitted a monitoring plan.















SEAP/SECAP according to specific guidelines, list of concrete actions in each sector.












